Co-fiananced Programmes

1. **GERSS: Short Term Research Stay**
Total of 120.000 Euro (equally shared)
2. **GERLS: Long Term Research Stay**
Total of 15,5 Mio. Euro (70% MoHE, 30% DAAD)
3. **GESP: Mobility of Research**
Total of 100.000 Euro (equally shared)
4. **GERF: Joint Research Fund**
Total of 2 Mio. Euro (equally shared)



Transformation Partnership

The Transformation Partnership focuses on strengthening the transition process in Egypt and Tunisia by the means of cooperation between German and Egyptian or Tunisian universities in different areas of research

1. Programme Strand 1: Transformation Partnership
16 three-year projects
2. Programme Strand 2: Short-term Cooperation
approx. 50 short-term projects
3. Programme Strand 3: Joint Master Programs
2 three-year projects
4. Programme Strand 4: Research Partnerships
9 projects (70.000Euro/year each)
